- Bring a reusable water bottle to protect the environment from single-use plastics
- Kindly use the provided litter bins
- Do not feed the fish or wildlife
- Please help us protect cultural artifacts by not touching the artworks
- Photos and videos are encouraged, not at the Studio or Sacred Area
- Do not take photos of other people without their consent
- Respect religious differences and customs and regard to rights of others
- No urinating in the open spaces, please use our dedicated restrooms
- Do not litter, kindly use the provided litter and recycling bins
- Contribute to our ecofriendly sustainability, please do not waste water, electricity and food
- Photos are allowed during Griot-Led Tours but refrain from taking videos or audio recordings
- Please show extra courtesy to seniors, children, the sick, disabled and pregnant women

## SACRED AREA RULES

- Access the Sacred Area from the main entrance only
- Do not enter the Sacred Area without a Griot
- Remain solemn and prayerful, refrain from talking loudly or arguing
- Remove shoes before entering the space to show respect to the ancestors and to ground yourself with nature
- Do not include people in photos of the artwork
- Be respectful of each other and honor the purpose of your visit as a spiritual moment
